We know you have questions and concerns regarding the Coronavirus Virus (COVID-19) and how it might affect Jumonville. We are following the guidance of the Centers for Disease Control (“CDC”) and American Camp Association to ensure that we are doing everything possible to support the efforts to slow and stop the spread of this illness.

Please know that we have reviewed and updated our policies and procedures in connection to our healthcare, on-site cleanliness and support of guests who have concerns. Our resident staff health officer is monitoring the updates from the CDC and staying in contact with local health authorities. She, in conjunction with our camp physician, will take all necessary precautions to keep our campers safe. We are committed to the safety of all of our campers and guests and will continue to monitor the situation closely and follow the advice of our local and national agencies in regard to our response.

If you are planning to visit the mountain soon (and we hope you are), we ask the following:

- If you are feeling ill, please stay home, and come see us when you feel better
- We are providing additional on-site hand-sanitation and washing stations. Please use them!
- We love to have fun at camp, and have created a “Greeting of the Day” to share hospitality with each other in creative ways (that don’t involve handshakes)
- If you become symptomatic while on our site, you must immediately inform our staff.
