TITLE:

The title shall be ADVENTURE STAFF

QUALIFICATIONS:

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE: Minimum of 18 years old. Previous experience in a multitude of adventure activities and equipment and operation is critical. Must have up to date Background Clearances as required by the State of Pennsylvania.

CONVICTIONS: Must have Christian convictions in keeping with the doctrines and policies of the Christian faith and the United Methodist Church.

SCOPE AND IMPACT OF DUTIES:

The cheerful, efficient performance of the duties of adventure staff, adds to the smooth operation of Jumonville's facilities and adds to the success of a Jumonville summer camp experience. Since this person works directly with counselors, staff and campers, it is important that actions and attitudes are consistent with the principles of Christian love and concern for persons. The safety of campers, by following protocols as set up within the Jumonville adventure program, is of utmost importance. **You will need to be resourceful, versatile, flexible, and be willing to do whatever is needed.**

PRINCIPLES OF EMPLOYMENT:

Jumonville's Summer Staff Personnel Policies shall pertain to this position.

LINE OF AUTHORITY:

This position works under the direct supervision of the Program Coordinator.

SPECIFIC DUTIES:

This description of duties is not intended to limit activity but, rather, to define areas of responsibility. It is expected that as situations arise calling for action, they will be handled expeditiously.

1. Assist in training of summer campers and guest groups in adventure activities.
2. Assist in facilitating summer campers and guest groups in the challenge/ropes course, the Ben Cromer Adventure Center, Multi-Level course, mountainboarding, archery, portable initiatives, rock climbing, etc.
3. Assist in the inventory of adventure/outdoor equipment whenever requested.
4. Assist in organizing and cleaning the adventure center and/or equipment used in the Adventure program.
5. Perform any maintenance work needed on the challenge/ropes course and adventure center under the direction of the Program Coordinator..
6. Be available as a resource person for adventure camps as requested.
7. Assist in the development of training materials (manuals, videos, etc.) used in adventure training.
8. Assist in any other duties as may be specified by camp leadership.
